

BOTTINEAU COUNTY
COMMISSIONER PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 21st, 2014
1:00 P.M.

The Commissioner Meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm. by Chairman Dan Marquardt. A meeting of the Board of Bottineau County Commissioners was held in the Community Room at the Courthouse with the following members present: Chairman Dan Marquardt, Commissioners, LeRoy Rude and Jeff Beyer and County Auditor, Lisa Herbel.

Brad Robertson, Greg Hagen and Robert Indvik, Wold Engineering, were in attendance to discuss the easement process with the land owners who will be affected by the Long Lake Loop Project.

Robert Indvik explained that easements leave the landowner as the owner, but allows the County to come in and do construction on their property. There are three options available to the landowners –

- Donate the land
- Accept the Counties easement policy which is \$800.00 per acre for a permanent easement and \$300.00 per acre for a temporary easement or
- Ask for a land appraisal

The landowners were also informed that \$2.25 per linear foot was available for fencing.

Discussion was held and the meeting was adjourned at 1:50 pm.
